



# **Native flora and fauna legislation**

In NSW & QLD laws exist which protect native fauna and flora. Below are links to the legislation for each state.

#### **New South Wales**

#### **Flora**

The NSW Native Vegetation Act 2003 and the Native Vegetation Regulation 2013 were repealed on 25 August 2017. Clearing of native vegetation on rural land is legislated by the Local Land Services Act 2013 and the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016. #### **Fauna**

This website lists the species which are protected under NSW legislation as well as a couple of native species which are listed as agricultural pests and are therefore exempt under the legislation.
