Manage the risk to your farm business this season

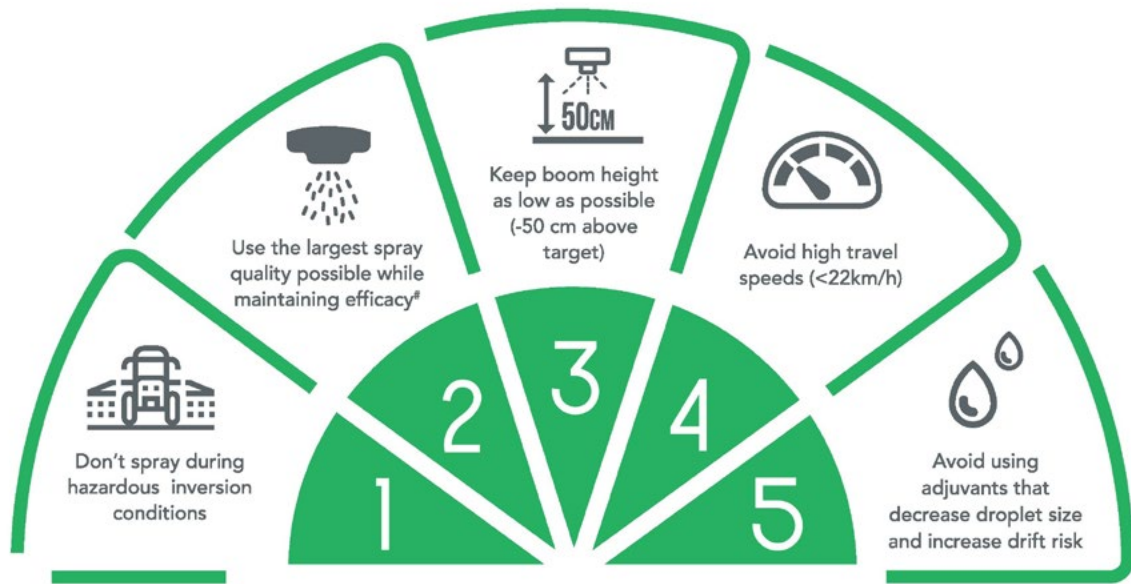
- Register your crops on SataCrop and talk to your neighbours about your plans
- Notify your neighbours when spraying
- Talk to staff to ensure they are fully trained and know when to STOP spraying
- Know the weather conditions at the spray application site
- Use the WAND towers to determine hazardous inversion conditions
- Ask your Agronomist to ensure you are using the right chemical for the job
- Follow the SOS NSW 5 commandments of good spray practice
- Keep compliant spray records
- Understand your responsibilities under the relevant legislation for your state when spraying for yourself or someone else.
- Report any incident within 24 hours using the Snap Send Solve app developed by Cotton Australia.

Observe label directions for minimum and maximum droplet size. Water rates may need to be modified with increased droplet sizes.

Spray it right or lose the right

CONSEQUENCES FOR SPRAY DRIFT

FINES:

- record keeping, \$150 to \$750 for individuals
- prosecutions \$22,000 for individuals and \$44,000 for corporations.
- spraying for a mate without a ground applicator licence up to \$120,000 for an individual
- Civil legal action and financial penalties.

ONGOING INCIDENTS CAN RESULT IN PRODUCTS BEING WITHDRAWN FROM SALE.
